



Archemedis

Hybrid Sweet Bell **Pepper** with Blocky 4 x 4.5 in/10 X 11 cm, 3-4 lobed, green to red bell. No streaks fruit. These are VERY easy to grow and will not disappoint you! Great taste



Badger

Sweet bell hybrid that matures early and uniformly to a bright-red color. Large, firm, high-quality, green-to-red, deep, blocky fruits on a tall vigorous plant. Suited for mature red fresh delicious sautee' grill or salads. YUM!



Bell Boy (aka Red Knight)

Red Knight is an early-maturing and blocky bell pepper. It produces an extra large fruit that goes from green to bright red at maturity. Because of its large size, Red Knight makes an excellent stuffing and grilling pepper.



Dan's Favorite Pepper

Produces a continuous set of large to extra-large, 3 and 4 lobed fruits on a small to medium sized plant. Fruits are anthocyaninless and appear to have good field tolerance for epidermal separation. One of the largest sized pepper we grow!



Purple Beauty

Delightful purple bell pepper, producing a continuous set of large to x large 3-4 lobed fruits on medium sized plant. Delicious in taste, gorgeous color!



Revolution

Green to red bell This is an outstanding bell pepper variety that produces a concentrated set even in cool weather. Extra-large, blocky thick-walled peppers are four-lobed, about 4½ inches long and wide, with firm flesh turning from green to brilliant red. Resistant to phytophthora, 4 races of bacterial leaf spot, and cucumber mosaic virus.

Tequila

A true purple sweet bell, deep in color with early maturity. Its 3 to 4-lobed fruits mature to a medium red. Attractive fruits make excellent stuffed peppers and stir-fries. Resists Tobacco Mosaic Virus.



Turnpike

Turnpike is a beautiful blocky bell pepper that offers resistance to Bacterial Leaf Spot (0-5, 7-9), Phytophthora blight, and Tomato Mosaic Virus. Its thick-walled fruit ripen from deep green to red and measure 4.75" long x 4.5" wide. The 22-26" plants have a concentrated set and offer good protection to the fruit. Turnpike packs a strong punch in the fight against diseases.



Golden Heat

A very high-yielding hot pepper. Very thin flesh that turns bright-red. Very hot when red and a somewhat concentrated set that is early for the type.



Mesilla

Hybrid Cayenne type, producing 11" long x 1-1/2" wide fruit that taper to a point. The fruit ripen from green to brilliant red and are wrinkled at the stem end. Mesilla's large, upright plant offer good cover to the fruit and are productive throughout the whole growing season.



Portugal Hot

Hot Portugal Pepper is an annual vegetable plant that is typically grown for its edible qualities, although it does have ornamental merits as well. It produces olive green long peppers (which are technically 'berries') with red flesh which are typically harvested when mature. The fruit will often fade to scarlet over time.



Mariachi

Hybrid fruit is 2 inches across at the shoulders to 4 inches long. GORGEOUS and COLORFUL! Coned shaped fruits that change brilliantly from creamy yellow to bright red. Plant grows 18" to 24" tall. 2006 All-America Winner. 500 to 600 Scoville Heat Unit. (That means it's not too hot for you milder folks)



Italian Roaster

Deliciously spice up any dish with the mild to medium heat. The tapered, thin-walled fruit is ideal for grilling and makes a great addition to burgers and sandwiches, seeds and all! Mature fruits are about 8-9" long. This hybrid Pepper plant was bred to resist viruses and produces prolifically. Green to red when mature



Bhut Jolokia

The hottest pepper we grow, also known as "Ghost Pepper". Prolific hot dark green peppers (turns red when mature) on stalky plants, use caution when eating or drying seeds. Not for the "faint of heart!" but will add a tremendous KICK to any dish or salsa!



Hungarian Hot Wax

Old time favorite hot banana pepper- great for pickling or slicing, using in salsa or adding spice to your recipes. 6 to 8 in long, yellow to orange to red (when mature). Only 10,000 on Scoville Heat Unit. Pick early yellow for pickling- will get hotter as they mature.



Primero Red

Habanero Primero Red hot pepper tastes like traditional habanero peppers but with only about one-third of the heat. One of the earliest ripening habaneros available, you'll enjoy huge yields of fruit as early as 60 days after planting. Good for cooler climates



Inferno Banana

Inferno Pepper Plant : Banana shaped mildly hot peppers from the USA that produces good yields of 8" long by 1 1/2" wide fruit. An early producing Hungarian Wax hybrid. Peppers ripen from lime green through orange to red. Great early variety used fresh in salads, frying, or pickling. 2500-4500 Scoville units.



Rey Pakal

Habanero type . Vigorous healthy plant that provides prolonged, high yielding harvests. Uniform 2-1.5 in/5-4 cm fruit mature from green to medium-dark red in color and are extremely hot!



Super Chili

Super Chili is a very productive, semi-compact plant that produces a **upward-facing cone shaped chili peppers** with a spicy flavor. Super Chili peppers are great for ornamental use as well. The fruits turn from pale green to orange to red with all shades in between.



Time Bomb

Time Bomb Pepper produces red, hot cherry peppers with a light smoky flavor. It produces fruit with about 1,000 Scoville units. It has light heat. Time Bomb Peppers are great pickled, processed, stuffed or chopped into salsas. These peppers measure about 2" x 2" .



Catarino

Catarino' is a jumbo-sized **jalapeno hybrid**. It's dark-green fruit, has broad shoulders, tapered to a blunt point. This Super-Sized Gowan Exclusive brings the heat! Very thick walls and heavy fruit weight. Excellent shelf life, and fruit setting ability assure high yield potential.



Jedi

Jedi is a prolific jalapeno variety that produces large fruits (4 1/2" long) with thick walls, while boasting excellent flavor. This is one of the preferred varieties for market growers and home growers for its dependable high yields, sturdy plants, and crack resistant. In addition, Jedi has high resistance to bacterial leaf spot (BLS), making it an excellent choice for growers who have problems with BLS in their pepper beds.



Bos 0575

Bos 0575 is a dark green jalapeno best known for it's excellent disease resistance while boasting great flavor.



Holy Mole

The Holy Mole pepper is an award-winning hybrid variety of pepper reminiscent of pasilla peppers, which are dry peppers used in Mexican cuisine. Holy Mole peppers are long and narrow with a length of up to 7 to 9 inches and a width of less than 2 inches.



Altiplano

Large-fruited serrano. An impressive size at 4 1/2-5" long, Altiplano peppers are faster to harvest than types with smaller fruits. Traditional serrano flavor and pungency. Medium-large plants.



Takara

A special hybrid version of the classic open-pollinated Shishito type with the same shape, size and quality, but with better uniformity. Small, 3 1/2" by 1" fruits have a mild, but rich flavor. Our favorite sauteeing pepper! Delicious but not too hot.



Ducado

Smooth, mostly straight, **sweet banana** with brilliant yellow coloration turning to red at full maturity. Used for both fresh market and processing. Ideal where bacterial leaf spot is a concern.



Carmen

Carmen peppers have a robust sweetness even when young on the vine, and their wide cavity and thicker walls make them very versatile in the kitchen – from stuffing to roasting and grilling. The **Carmen pepper** really does it all – which is why it's an All-America Selections (AAS) winning plant.



Sweet Delilah

Sweet Delilah is a Marconi type Sweet Pepper that has a vigorous plant habit and very high yield, with medium early maturity and a very long lasting production. The uniform, mostly three lobed fruits average 9 inches long by 2.5 inches and tapers down to a blunt point giving average weights of 210 grams. Sweet Delilah fruit matures green to rich deep red with outstanding luster.



Cherry Pick Sweet

Fruits measure 1-1/4" by 1-1/4" and are uniform in size and shape. Yield is superb, with tall, 24", vigorous plants setting loads of sweet, dark green fruits that mature to red, although normally harvested in the green stage. Makes excellent pickled peppers. Disease resistant and about 25% larger than the old strains.

Cayenne

Cayenne peppers are long, thin green to red peppers that are quite spicy yet tasty. They contain a wide variety of vitamins and nutrients, whether eaten raw, grilled, sautee'd or dried! Loads of fruit all season long.



Gypsy

Gypsy pepper is a small **SWEET** pepper that averages around four inches long. The structure of this pepper resembles that of a bell pepper at the top and a jalapeno at its tapered end. It's a favorite with home gardeners, as it is prolific, sweet, versatile and easy to grow. Light green to orange when mature, it can be harvested through every stage.



Habanero

Habaneros are a small but **HOT** fruit that (this particular variety we grow in packs) ripen from green to bright red. Small slightly wrinkled lantern shaped peppers on a medium sized plant. Produces all summer. Use in salsas, grilled or pickled.



Hungarian Hot Wax

Old time favorite hot banana pepper- great for pickling, slicing (raw or cooked) using in salsa or adding spice to your recipes. 6 to 8 in long, yellow to orange to red (when mature). Only 10,000 on Scoville Heat Unit. Pick early yellow for pickling- will get hotter as they mature.



Jalapeno

This variety (in our 4 packs) produces a smaller jalapeno than the ones we grow in pints, if you don't need a super sized fruit. medium stalky plants that shouldn't require staking. Green to red when mature



Keystone Resistant Giant #3

The plant produces heavy yields of large 4 1/2" long by 3 1/2" wide sweet bell peppers. Peppers have thick walls and turn from green to red when mature. Produces well even under adverse weather conditions. A perfect stuffing pepper. An excellent choice for home gardens, market growers, and open field production. Disease Resistant: TMV.
